How We Prepare Your Home for a Long-Lasting Finish

1.



Power Washing

We thoroughly power wash all exterior surfaces to remove dirt, dust, mildew, and loose debris. Why it matters: Clean surfaces ensure proper paint adhesion and a longer-lasting finish.

Trenching

We dig a 4–6 inch trench around the foundation of the home and apply paint to act as a protective sealant. This helps prevent moisture intrusion beneath the exterior paint.

2.



Stucco Repairs

Cracks, chips, and damaged stucco are repaired to restore a solid, uniform surface. All repairs are blended to match surrounding areas, creating a smooth foundation for even paint coverage.

Caulking Cracks & Gaps

We seal gaps around windows, doors, trim, and joints using high-quality exterior caulk. Proper caulking prevents moisture intrusion and improves durability while giving your home a clean, finished look.

Patching Minor Damage

Small holes, surface flaws, and worn areas are patched and leveled using professional-grade materials. This step eliminates imperfections that would otherwise show through the finished paint.

7.



Sanding Surfaces

Rough, peeling, or uneven areas are sanded to create a smooth, paint-ready surface. Sanding improves paint adhesion and ensures a clean, professional finish.

4.



Masking & Protection

Windows, doors, fixtures, landscaping, and non-painted areas are carefully masked and covered. This protects your property and ensures crisp, clean paint lines throughout the project.

Priming

High-quality primer is applied where needed to seal surfaces and promote proper paint adhesion. Priming ensures even color, enhances durability, and extends the life of the finished paint job.
