1.

Move Furniture

Furniture, artwork, and personal items are carefully moved or covered to protect them during painting. This allows full access to surfaces and keeps your home clean and safe.

Drywall Repair

Damaged drywall or texture issues are repaired as needed to restore the surface. Proper repairs ensure a clean, long-lasting finish.

Mask Surfaces

Floors, windows, and surrounding areas are masked, and switch plates and outlets are removed. This ensures clean lines and prevents paint from reaching unintended surfaces.



6.

Sand Surfaces

Walls and ceilings are sanded to smooth repairs and remove high spots. This creates an even, paint-ready surface.



3.

Caulking

Cracks and gaps in walls, trim, and ceilings are sealed with professional-grade caulk. This creates a smooth appearance and helps prevent future cracking.



7.

Priming

Primer is applied where necessary to seal surfaces and improve paint adhesion. This ensures even color coverage and durability.



4.

Patching

Small holes, dents, and surface imperfections are patched and leveled. This step creates a uniform surface for proper paint adhesion.



8.

Final Dusting & Cleanup

All surfaces are dusted and cleaned before painting begins. This prevents debris from affecting the final finish.
